Serve-a-thon Fundraiser

The North Shore Stars Volleyball Club has been developing players and leaders through volleyball since 2007.

Our club was created to meet the growing demand among young girls to be active and involved in the sport of volleyball. Each year, our club continues to expand as enthusiasm for the sport swells. In addition to our club teams, we plan to run our very popular youth league this spring so that all who want to play volleyball can do so.

The purpose of our annual Serve-a-Thon is to raise funds for transportation, accommodation and expenses for provincial and national championships. Partial proceeds from this fundraiser also donated to community programs. As an added benefit, the players have an opportunity to practice their serving when the stakes are high!

1. Players will be required to make 100 attempted serves
2. Players will pair up and each player will take turns at 25 serve intervals
3. The player's partner will count the attempts and successful serves
4. Only those serves landing in the court will be counted towards the amount of the pledge
5. Pledges will be collected within one week of the event or donations can be made at the time of the pledge
